Salvia coccinea

“The gift of beauty that keeps on giving.” This all-summer-blooming beauty is almost too easy to grow. Its greatest blessing is its worst vice. When left to go to seed it generously self-sows..... More plants at no cost! Does best in sun but half shade doesn't slow it down. For continuous bloom, it prefers regular pinching back, every two or three weeks. Its nectar-rich tubular flowers are great butterfly and hummingbird attractors. Get three or four small plants and you're set for life. Seedlings are easy to remove if they become too plentiful.
