- Submitting your entry authorizes Ixia Chapter FNPS and Cork Arts District to publish your images for purposes of exhibition/show publicity. All artist credits will be included. We may ask select artists to provide higher resolution jpegs suitable for publishing.
- Selected artists may be highlighted on Ixia Chapter FNPS and Cork Arts District websites, social media, and/or written collateral promoting the exhibit/show.
- *There is no entry fee for the exhibition. A \$20 donation to Florida Native Plant Society – Ixia Chapter is suggested.*
- All donations will go to further the mission of the Florida Native Plant Society.
- All artworks must be on display and cannot be removed from the exhibition/show for the entire designated time.
- *Accepted works must be for sale.*
- Sales are dealt with directly through Ixia Chapter FNPS. *Artists receive 80% of the sale price of their work. Ixia Chapter receives 20% of the sale price of each artist's work. Artists are welcome to donate a higher percentage of their sales at their discretion.*
- Artists are required to read, sign, and complete their Artist Contract & Inventory Forms before drop-off time on September 26th, 2026
