Florida prohibits developers from burying gopher tortoises in their burrows, requiring them to relocate the animals out of harm's way. But sprawl has destroyed so much of the tortoises' habitat that there are fewer and fewer places to relocate them. Instead of working to protect more habitat, state officials recently issued an order to [make it easier for developers to keep building](#) — weakening rules that protect the imperiled animals during the relocation process.

Not only is the order bad for tortoises, it signals the agency's larger failure to prioritize the habitat these animals need to survive. Weak protections for gopher tortoise habitat means weak protections for the hundreds of other species that use tortoise burrows as their homes — and the very best parts of wild Florida, from pine sandhills to oak scrub.
